"Escape the OTC Aisle": An Evaluation of a Self-Care Focused Escape Room

 Author Names

INTRODUCTION:

- AACP has recommended the use of games to prepare students for practice

OBJECTIVE:

- To develop and assess an escape room activity to engage students in content review for an advanced self-care elective

METHODS:

- Students were randomly placed in teams of 6-7 and had 60 minutes to complete the escape room activity
- 4 identical escape rooms were used simultaneously to accommodate class size
- Designed to mimic recreational escape rooms but puzzles required students to utilize self-care knowledge
- At the end of the activity, a 9-item Likert-scale survey was distributed to gauge student perception of learning

RESULTS:

- 50/55 students (90%) completed the survey
- 49 students (98%) agreed they enjoyed the activity
- 48 students (96%) agreed they would like to have more of these activities in the curriculum

IMPLICATIONS:

- "Escape the OTC Aisle" was perceived to be enjoyable and useful as a review tool for students
- The room will continue to be utilized in this course

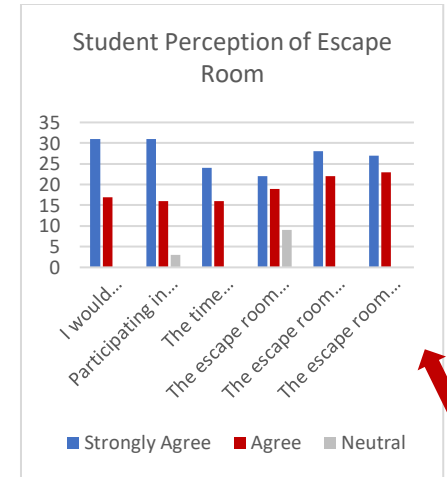
Self-Care focused Escape Room was a useful review tool for students.
